
Welcome Back!

2022 Reunion Details 92nd Year- Stepping Back in Time A Day of Family Stories and History

The 2022 Steere Reunion will be held at the farmstead of the late Robert E. Steere (61-51) and Mary Sayles Steere (404-23) on Victory Highway in Chepachet, RI. This farm dates back from 1930 when Mr. and Mrs. Steere were married. The farmhouse was built that year by George Andrew Steere (409-3), who was a carpenter and builder by trade. The modern garage and turkey processing building were built in the early 1950's by Ernest and Steve Hopkins, the latter still a regular attendee at Steere reunions.

Mr. and Mrs. Steere lived at this farm for a half century, raising about 1000 turkeys annually through the 1950s and later growing, picking, and selling about 5000 dozen ears of sweet corn every year. Later, the fields were sown to hay and for many years were farmed by George O. Steere, Sr. (404-25) and then by his son George O. Steere, Jr. (404-59), who still bales hay there today. Robert E. Steere, Jr., (61-66), inherited the property in 1999, and his cousin Walter Mowry Olney Steere, III (404-), resided here for several years. Upon Robert's death, the property passed to his family. Jeffrey Steere (404-), the grand nephew of Mary Sayles Steere, then bought the farm in 2021. Jeffrey and his wife Jen have spent much time renovating, repairing, and modernizing the house and fixing up other parts of the property. It still operates as a farm, producing annually about 1000 bales of hay. They have renamed the farm from "Rhodesylvania Farm" to what is now known as "Four Square Farm" as the house is a traditional four square house. We are excited they have open up their farm to host this years event. During the remodel they found a diary written by the late Mrs. Mary Steere and will be sharing passages from it.

Mary and Bob Steere were very active in the Steere Family Association. He served as President and later as Registrar for many years. It was at this farm that the John Steere Family Branches was compiled and written by Mr. Steere, assisted by his wife. Both also did a lot of work on the John Steere Family Album. Mr. and Mrs. Steere were also hosts to numerous family members coming to Chepachet to attend the Steere Reunion and other events. It is very appropriate that the Steere family gather in 2022 at this beautiful and historic farm with so many connections to members of our family.
